

## **Internships**

As a major in anthropology, geography, sociology, or global studies, you have the option of participating in internship opportunities with local businesses, government agencies, and non-profit organizations for up to six hours of elective credit. During an internship, you will have the chance to work alongside professionals in the real world, apply what you have learned in the classroom, make connections with local community members, develop relationships with professionals in the fields of your career interests, and potentially find a future employer.

## Eligibility

- For GSS majors ONLY
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Students must have completed (or be currently enrolled in) SYA 3300
  Research Methods

## **Course Requirement**

- Students must enroll in SYA 3949 simultaneously with the internship and will receive a grade for the internship course. This grade is based on the following: completion of hours, a field journal, a final paper, and an evaluation from their internship supervisor.
- All credit-earning internships obtained through SYA 3949 earn 3 credits per semester. Up to 6 internship credits, spread over any two semesters, can be applied to a GSS major.
- Internship Work Hours Requirement: Fall, Spring, or Summer C internships require 10-12 internship work hours per week for credits. Half-term internships (e.g., Summer A or B term) require 20-24 hours per week.
